

## California Native Plants used in the Palomares House garden

The Palomares House gardens were renovated in 2022 with funding from the County of San Diego Watersmart Rebate Program and SoCalWaterSmart. Non-native, high water use lawns and hedges were replaced with easy to grow, drought tolerant California native plants that provide habitat for wildlife, especially pollinators. Plants are irrigated with low-flow emitters by a weather smart irrigation controller and soil moisture is retained by sheet mulching (a layer of cardboard or newspaper covered with mulch). Gutters funnel rain into rain barrels, which overflow into rain gardens that allow the water to sink into the ground. Berms along the fence line prevent runoff from flowing into the street. FLC Volunteers generously gave their time to do most of the renovation work.
