APPLETON	22.98	West side of La Canada Rd GPS 33.3131, -117.2188	No	A gentle walk along La Canada gives views to the west of Appleton Preserve riparian habitat.
BONSALL	27.36	S. Mission Rd. & Hwy 76 (NW corner) GPS 33.294598, -117.223177	No	A largely inaccessible wetlands area preserved for wildlife. A short boardwalk offers view of wetlands.
DINWIDDIE	14.5	S. Stagecoach Ln & Brooke Rd across from Palomares House GPS 33.357506, -117.231159	Yes	Small non-native grassland & wetland area with oak, willow, & sycamore, bench, great for bird watching.
DURLING	184	DeLuz Area	No	Closed to public for biological studies and sensitive habitat.
ENGEL FAMILY	10.37	Sumac Rd ~1/2mi off Pala Mesa Dr. GPS 33.339622,-117.168750	Yes	Scenic area with a trail to rock outcropping and ridgeline & panoramic views of Monserate Mtn. Preserve and Palomar Mtn.
HELLERS BEND	48.55	South end of Hellers Bend Rd off of S. Mission Rd. GPS 33.315108, -117.234146	Yes	Riparian area, steep trail through live oak forest up to panoramic views of Monserate Mtn. and Margarita Peak. Dirt trail continues through spectacular coastal sage habitat.
LOS JILGUEROS	43.5	S. Mission Rd just north of Fallbrook High School GPS 33.35376, -117.245364	Yes	Beautiful preserve near the heart of Fallbrook with a variety of looping trails through field & riparian forest. Ponds and Firescape gardens offer wonderful bird watching opportunities.
MARGARITA PEAK	1206	Remote NW corner of SD Cnty GPS 33.443904, -117.389688	No	Closed to public for biological studies in remote area of Northwest San Diego county with highest peak west of Hwy 15.
MONSERATE MOUNTAIN	340	Stewart Canyon Rd at Pankey just east of I-15 overpass GPS 33.365939, -117.15904	Yes	Steep trail thru coastal sage, native grassland and chaparral habitats to panoramic views from ocean to eastern mountains.
PALOMARES HOUSE & PARK	1.57	1815 Stagecoach Ln. GPS 33.357757, -117.231696	Yes	Restored farmhouse used for FLC office spaces and meeting room. Beautiful walkway through a memorial garden with lovely native plantings, arboretum and native wildlife sculptures.
ROCK MOUNTAIN	78	Sandia Creek Rd, ~1.5mi north of Santa Margarita River GPS 33.432812, -117.246831	Yes	Steep trail up through coastal sage scrub habitat to rock outcropping & riparian habitat along Bryant's Creek.
